

## THOMAS CAMBRIDGE – BIO

Originally from Amarillo, Texas, Thomas Cambridge is a multi-faceted, adept leader, with a life and career that has spanned the arts, science, and business. He has been a corporate executive, a technologist, a mentor, an actor, a comedy writer, an improvisation performer, and a small business owner. Whether in front of the camera or the boardroom, he strives to apply high levels of passion in whatever he pursues at a particular point in his life. Thomas has successfully led global corporate initiatives, driven large organizational change, and delivered principle roles onstage in theatrical Off-Broadway productions in New York City.

Thomas began his professional career in 1983, after graduating from the University of Texas at Austin, where he worked for The Railroad Commission of Texas. In 1986, he moved to New York City to enter the world of finance, first at Shearson Lehman Hutton, and then UBS. Over his 22-year career at UBS, he successfully drove global initiatives that spanned software and technology infrastructure. During his last five years, he was employed as Chief of Staff for Networks and then End User Services across the whole of UBS, where he managed programs related to resource offshoring, leadership & development, organizational communications, innovation, and risk management.

In 2013, Thomas launched his acting career, with study in comedy improvisation, writing, and on camera acting and technique. Since then, he has been on national television numerous times, as well as stage productions. He is skilled at delivering a variety of rich characters and dialects, and includes playing the piano and guitar, and singing in his artistic offerings. He is a writer and cast member of Comedy Tribe, a sketch comedy team based in Narrowsburg, NY. His next feature film, a thriller entitled “An Angry Boy”, is due for release in Spring, 2023.

In May of 2022, Thomas became the Executive Director of non-profit organization Growing Older Together, a volunteer organization that enables seniors to maintain an independent life and reside in the home of their choice. His objectives include driving the Board of Directors’ strategic goals in the areas of fund raising and membership / volunteer growth. Growing Older Together serves Wayne and Pike Counties in Pennsylvania, and Sullivan County in New York.

Thomas received an MBA in Finance from New York University and has studied acting in New York City with the Upright Citizens Brigade, HB Studio, and Penny Templeton Studio. He lives in Cocheton, New York with his Labrador Retriever Maude.
